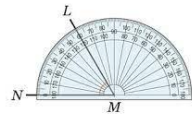




Maths



In Class 2 pupils will be learning more about money, time, shape, position and direction, and statistics. In Year 5 and 6 pupils will be learning about properties of shapes, including angles, position and direction, decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume. Both classes will also focus on solving problems within these topics.

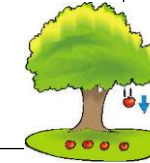
English

Pupils will continue to write imaginatively through the use of stories or film. Class 2 will be using the myth Theseus and the Minotaur to inspire their writing and Class 3 pupils will use a short film called The Present to gather ideas for their stories. We are also excited to be learning our lines for this year's summer performance.

Science

In Year 3 and 4 pupils will learn about skeletal and muscular systems. We will also learn about the digestive system.

In Year 5 and 6 pupils are learning about forces, including gravity and air resistance.



PSHE

In Class 2 we will focus on relationships and how we can improve communication and collaboration.

In Class 3 we will focus on health and wellbeing and how to keep ourselves safe.

Art/DT

Our Art this term is based upon nature and the pupils will be encouraged to create pieces of art using materials they find outside.

In DT we are linking our work on sustainability to find out more about eating seasonally.



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History/Geography



In our History lessons this term we will be learning all about The Tudors. We will find out more about Henry VIII and his eight wives and learn about the creation of the Church of England after the Pope refused to give Henry a divorce!

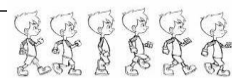
In Geography we will start off by learning about the local area. Following on from this we will find out about life in cities and how people can live more sustainably.

PE

We are continuing our swimming lessons at Framlingham College Pool. In our PE lessons at school we will be focussing on our athletic skills ready for Sports Day.
