



Maths

In Ash Class this term we will be focussing on place value, addition, subtraction and multiplication. Both classes will also focus on solving problems within these topics.

We will be focusing on learning the following times tables: 10x, 2x, 5x and 3x.

English

Literacy lessons this term will begin with writing butterfly poems. Lessons will subsequently focus on 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy' by Oliver Jeffers. We will be using the text to learn how to use punctuation and grammar correctly in our sentences and to build a rich vocabulary ready for our independent writing tasks. These will include writing both formal and informal letters and, after half-term, a story.

Science

In Ash Class the children will learn about solids, liquids and gases and their characteristic properties. They will observe how materials change state as they are heated and cooled, and learn key terminology associated with these processes. After half term they will learn about the wider properties of materials and their uses. They learn about mixtures and how they can be separated using sieving, filtration and evaporation. They study reversible and irreversible changes, and use common indicators to identify irreversible changes.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about living in the wider world, economic awareness and enterprise, and relationships- similarities and differences.

Art/DT

Our Art this term is linked to our topic about The Romans. We will be looking at Roman mosaics and how these were made. We will design our own mosaics and have a go at making a mosaic using card tiles.

History

Our history topic this term learning about the Roman Empire and Roman Britain. We will find out about how the Roman empire expanded, learn about daily life in Roman times and Julius Caesar and his failed attempts to conquer Britain. We will also learn about Boudicca and her campaign against the Roman Empire.

Music

In Ash Class this term we will be learning to play the djembe drum. We will learn how to read and play simple 4 beat rhythms both in unison and in layers to create increasingly complex textures.



Computing

Pupils will be learning about online safety and how to be SMART when going online.

Next, Year 3 and 4 pupils will learn about using email safely and about safe use of software and hardware.



French

In Ash Class this term we will be learning how to greet people, say how we are feeling, say who we are including where we live. We will also learn how to say numbers to 20 and relate them to objects.

PE

We are swimming this term at Framlingham College Pool. In our PE lessons in school we are focussing on tag rugby skills.

RE:

In RE we will be learning about what Christians mean when they talk about the Kingdom of God.
