



### Maths

In Oak Class this term we will be focussing on place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. We will also start our fractions topic.

### English

In Oak Class the children will explore the genre of Sci-fi through Doctor Who. We will use parts of an episode to help us improve our descriptive language. Later on, we will take part in the BBC 500 words lesson and have the opportunity to write our own short stories.

After half term we will look at inventions and explaining how a piece of technology works. We will also create our own book about things they love.

### Science

In Oak Class the children will learn about solids, liquids and gases and their characteristic properties. They will observe how materials change state as they are heated and cooled, and learn key terminology associated with these processes. After half term they will learn about the wider properties of materials and their uses. They learn about mixtures and how they can be separated using sieving, filtration and evaporation. They study reversible and irreversible changes and use common indicators to identify irreversible changes.

### PSHE

In Oak Class we will be learning about living in the wider world, economic awareness and enterprise, and relationships- similarities and differences.

## Oak Class Curriculum Newsletter – Autumn Term 2025

### Art

Our Art this term is linked to our topic about The Romans. We will be looking at Roman mosaics and how these were made. We will design our own mosaics and have a go at making a mosaic using card tiles.

### History

Our history topic this term learning about the Roman Empire and Roman Britain. We will find out about how the Roman empire expanded, learn about daily life in Roman times and Julius Caesar and his failed attempts to conquer Britain. We will also learn about Boudicca and her campaign against the Roman Empire.

### Music

In Oak Class this term we will be learning to play the djembe drum. We will learn how to read and play simple 4 beat rhythms both in unison and in layers to create increasingly complex textures.



### Computing



In computing this term we will be using our online learning platform Purple Mash. To begin with we will revisit online safety. In Year 4 pupils will learn about using email safely and about safe use of software and hardware. In Year 5 and 6 pupils will learn about quizzing and create their own games.

### French

In Oak Class this term we will be learning how to greet people, say how we are feeling, say who we are including where we live. We will also learn how to say numbers to 20 and relate them to objects.

### PE

We are swimming this term at Framlingham College Pool. In our PE lessons in school, we are focussing on tag rugby skills.

### RE:

In RE we will be learning about what Christians mean when they talk about the Kingdom of God.
