



Maths

In Year 4 this term we will consolidate our written methods for multiplication and division. We will also use our times tables to help us solve problems. In Year 5 and 6 we will finish our work on fractions before consolidating our written methods for multiplication and division. All pupils will use our maths knowledge to solve reasoning problems.

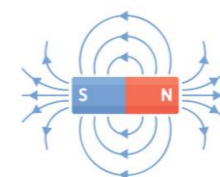
English

In Oak Class the children will use the short Disney film Feast to further improve our story writing.

Later on, we will complete an information text about Everest and finally we will look at writing our own playscript based upon the BBC Radio programme about the plague in Eyam.

Science

Science this term will focus on forces and magnets. Children will learn about contact and non-contact forces, including friction and magnetism. They will investigate frictional and magnetic forces and identify parts of a magnet and magnetic materials.



PSHE

Pupils in Year 4 will focus on friendships and health and safety.

Year 5 and 6 will focus on aspirations for the future and emotional wellbeing.

Art/DT

Our Art this term is Beautiful Botanicals. We will look carefully at botanical art and how the artists focus carefully on features of nature. We will draw detailed sketches of fruits and plants.

In DT we will look at healthy eating and prepare healthy meals.

Geography

This term our geography topic is Our Planet, Our World. We will be learning how to read maps and atlases, identifying human and physical features.

We will identify and compare different land uses within the UK.

Music

In music this term we will be embarking on a djembe drumming course set out by Charanga, our online music provider. We hope to perform at our next parent assembly.



Computing



In computing this term we will be using our online learning platform Purple Mash. In Year 4 pupils will learn about technology and how it helps us.

Year 5 and 6 will learn about using databases and how to create and interpret graphs.

French

In French this term we will be learning about colours and how to describe classroom equipment in terms of colour and size. We will also be learning to sing some French songs.

PE

Pupils in Year 4 will be focusing on dance, gymnastics and netball.

Year 5 and 6 pupils have Forest School sessions and then after half term pupils will focus on netball.
