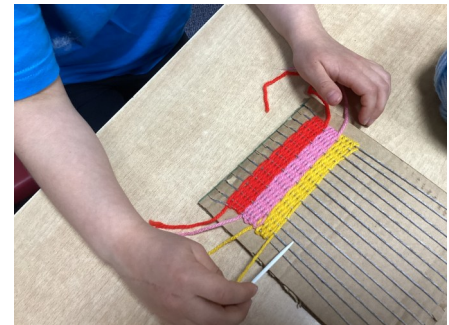


Mrs Foster gave the bay tree a good prune which meant we
